Gipriano Castro, president of Venezuela, who has made several great stirs in the world, will attend the Jamestown Exposition in his \$3,000,000 state yacht.

Kansas, through her governor, Edward W. Hoch, has accepted the invitation of the Jamestown Exposition management to participate in the Ter-Centennial celebration to be held near Norfolk, Va., on Hampton Roads in 1907. Gov. Hoch is especially interested as Kansas has planned a great International Exposition for 1911 and participation in the Jamestown event will make a great opportunity for the Sunflower state to exploit her own big show.

Veterans of the Civil War are manifesting intense interest in the Jamestown Exposition. The old war horses are eager to visit the scenes of their victories and defeats and they know that by visiting the Ter-Centennial celebration they will be in the heart of the great battlefield of the Nation.

### BEEF SCARCITY IN NEW YORK

(Scrapps News Association)  
New York, Oct. 5.—So scarce has been the supply of best quality beef that reports have lately been current of manipulation of the markets by the big dealers. Wholesale dealers in this city say that the price of the better grades of meat has materially increased during the past few months and attribute the raise to increase shipment to England. Beef of stall fed cattle now costs from \$6.95 to \$7.05 a hundred pounds on the hoof and sells dressed at 10 1/2 cents. In June before the supply commenced falling off beef on the hoof could be obtained at \$6.50 a hundred pounds.
