A GLASS BRIDGE

Colorado is about to astonish the world with a glass bridge. Across the gorge of the wonderful Grand Canon of the Arkansas river, near Canon City, a suspension bridge has been built more than twenty-six hundred feet above the surface of the river. Its floor is of plate glass, so that the tourists may look down into the wonderful gorge, the deepest in the Rockies. The floor of the bridge is about a mile and a half above sea level. An electric railway from Canon City will carry travelers to the edge of the gorge.—Ex.
