FOLK'S NEW RAILROAD POLICY

Farmington, Mo., Oct. 15—Governor Folk, who is known to oppose Government ownership of railroads, came out today in advocacy of a policy of more stringent Government supervision. The Governor favors a Government control similar to the present control of National banks by the Federal Government. He traveled with Mr. Bryan yesterday and spoke from the same platform. They held conferences on the issues of the day and presumably discussed Mr. Bryan's advocacy of Federal ownership. Mr. Folk said today:

"If there were a controller of railroads appointed by the President subject to removal at pleasure, with absolute power to suspend directors or officers of interstate railroads violating the law and appoint receivers to take charge of the road until the operators could furnish sufficient guarantee of more responsible management, the result should be to remedy evils now existing in railroad affairs."

"In other words, give the controller of railroads the power over railroads that the Federal Government now exercises thru the Comptroller of the Currency over National banks."

NEW YORK'S CUSTOM HOUSE

New York, Oct. 15—The contract time for the completion of New York's new Custom house expires today, but it will be some considerable time yet before it will be ready for occupancy. Recently Mr. Gilbert, the architect in charge of the work, secured an additional appropriation of \$450,000 from Congress to supply marble in the interior of the building instead of plaster as originally planned. The main rotunda will be especially elaborate. When completed the new Custom House will be the handsomest building of its kind in the world and will have cost \$1,200,000.
