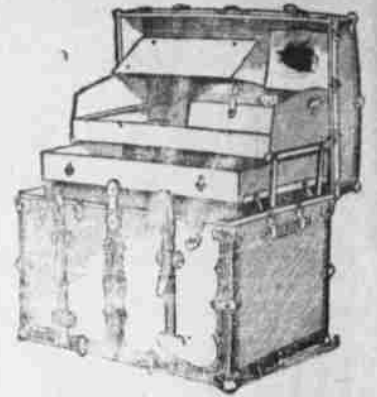

The carpet in the new city jail is all in place, consisting of four inches of cement. It will evidently last well.

It is expected that the legislature will pass a banking law, which will require an examination of state banks, similar to national banks.

Four crops of alfalfa have been cut this year from the college farm of the Agricultural college at Corvallis. Dr. Withcombe is confident that any fair wheat land in the Willamette valley will profitably grow alfalfa.

Without any desire to add to the burdens of the average citizen, who sweat and swore under the excessive heat of last summer, it will be well for him to bear in mind that the law of average temperature threatens him with a winter as cold as the summer was hot.

Mayor Stoddard is preparing for an active season next year, with his planing mill. Owing to the fact that he could not secure lumber which he could resell at a profit he practically withdrew from business this year. But he has arranged for plenty of lumber and expects to do his part in the upbuilding of this city and county.

The demand is so great for houses that there is a certainty that if La Grande is to grow there must be new houses for the increase in population and there is no question but what La Grande is growing and will continue to grow. Material and labor was so scarce this year that many deferred building in the belief that these difficulties would be easier to overcome another season.

It is quite likely that the coming legislature will transfer the collection of taxes from the sheriff's office to the county treasurer. It matters little to the general public and in reality means additional clerical force in the treasurer's office with a corresponding decrease in the sheriff's office. Under the new law which provides for the paying of taxes in two parts, the delinquent list is small and it receives itself to supply the receipts.

Capitalists in the Big Bend country offer to establish a plant for the manufacture of denatured alcohol provided they can secure contracts for three years for 75,000 tons of potatoes for which they agree to pay \$8 per ton. Grande Ronde will furnish the contracts and the potatoes for a similar industry.

Cities who think they have a grievance on account of excessive railroad rates, are applying for relief. Wonder how long it will be until Grande Ronde valley wakes up to the fact that we are paying an excessive rate when we pay the regular terminal rate from Chicago or other common eastern points to Portland and in addition thereto the local rate from Portland back to La Grande. We certainly are a patient people. Spokane did not wait twenty-four hours before she filed her protest.
