 New York, Oct. 30 - The order of Justice Dowling of the Supreme Court granted on a petition made by a large number of aliens to change their names comes into effect today. 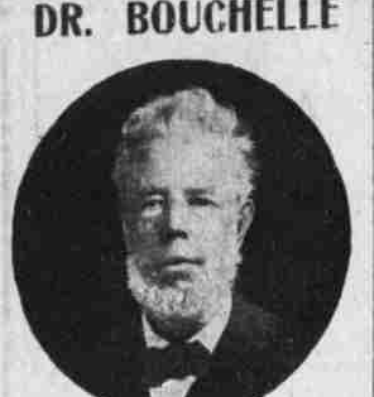
