Speaker of the House, Joseph Cannon, has just been elected for the 17th time to congress.

The election, if it means anything, means that the policy of Roosevelt is endorsed and will be continued.

The farmers generally are delighted with this rain, the best growers were not all quite ready.

Whaling is a growing industry in the South Atlantic, centering around the Falkland Islands. During December, January, and March 125 Sei whales and also a few sperm whales were captured in the vicinity of the island of South Georgia.

Germany and Japan have made good use of the idea, first suggested in the United States, of equipping ships with products for sale abroad and sending the vessels to the ports where trade might be developed. In that way, according to a report transmitted by Consul-General Michael, Japan got her first order from the Argentine Republic, with which she now has considerable trade.

It would be nothing but justice for councilmen of this city to receive some remuneration for their services. Few people realize the amount of time that is required of a councilman. Not only one or two midnight sessions each month but the committee work, which is by far the greatest time consumer. However the revenues of the city are not sufficient to increase our present salary list, neither do we presume that the present council would consider such a proposition.

SHOWS STATESMANSHIP

The following statement from Mr. Hushes during the period when there was a possibility of a reversal in the returns shows him to be conservative.

"I am very much gratified if I am elected, as now seems to be the case, but I am not accustomed to speak in detail upon matters about which there may be any uncertainty.

"I understand, however, that my election is pretty well assured, but whatever my plurality may be, my feeling is not one of elation, but of responsibility. That is all that I care to say at present."

DISTRESS IN LONDON

There is a large amount of distress in East London at the present time, and the prospects for the winter are gloomy, says the London Times. Trade in the docks is very quiet, and there is only little doing in the building line. The question of dealing with pauperism the coming winter is an anxious one for the public boards, who talk of reopening stone-crushing yards. In Woolwich borough where there is also much poverty the distress committee plans the emigration of hundreds of men during the next few months.

The next meeting of the city council which will meet two weeks from last night will be an unusually important one as Engineer Pickler will have completed his report which among other things will give his estimate of the cost and construction of the water supply from Beaver creek. The special committee who have the new charter under consideration will present their report.

Congressman Ellis in answer to the request of the council to take up the matter of a free delivery in this city, with the Postmaster General. We certainly are entitled to this service, have complied with the general conditions.
