WILL BE INDICTED FOR RIOT

That the four Japs from the Bingham Springs section crew will be indicted for riot was stated this afternoon by District Attorney Phelps. Under the law forbidding that crime it is specified that when three or more persons shall get together and indulge in certain acts, they shall be subject to a term in the penitentiary.

During their escapade at Bingham the Japs broke down the door of the car in which the O'Leary family was living; entered the car, flourished knives, threatened to kill young O'Leary and did various other things. Consequently Mr. Phelps regards the case as a good one for the application of the riot act. In his opinion foreign section men have become entirely too much addicted to such offenses as the one at Bingham station.
