BRITISH TRADE OUSTED BY AMERICANS

London, Eng., Nov. 21—In a consular report published today it is stated that there is a great falling off in trade between Mexico and Great Britain both in quantity and value, as compared with the United States. The report states geographical advantages possessed by the United States are offset by the great sea transportation which Britain can offer it being possible to ship freight from Liverpool to Vera Cruz cheaper than goods can be sent from New York Chicago, or other American centres to Tampico or Vera Cruz, or by rail alone to Mexico City. In conclusion the report states that the British have practically withdrawn from Mexico just at the time when the seed which they so plentifully had sown was about to fructify.

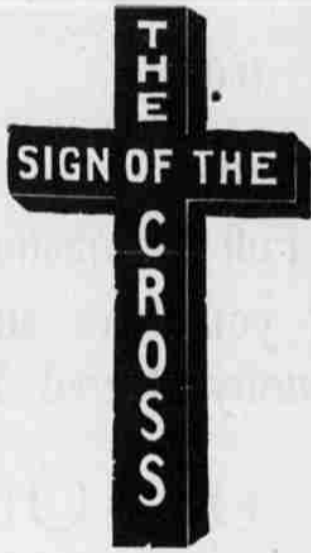
