GOVERNMENT TO RECLAIM ARID LAND

Washington, Nov. 27—A move will be made during the next sitting of Congress for a large appropriation for the purpose of reclaiming waste lands in a number of states. In the state of Louisiana alone it is stated there is a reclaimable area sufficient to support a population of 10,000,000 while all along the coast from Virginia to Texas is an extremely fertile and productive strip of vast aggregate extent under very shallow water. The small portions here and there brot under cultivation produces in abundance. It will be shown that the drainage of the Southern swamps and marshes means improvement of the health of the people as well as the creation of new wealth and that canals and drains dug thru the submerged area would give far reaching useful results.

JAPANESE FLEET FOR AMERICA

Yokahama, Nov. 27.—It was definitely announced here today that the fleet to make a tour of the world would be under command of Vice Admiral Shichiro Kalao-ka, though a comparatively young man was commander of the third squadron of Togos fleet and took part in the principal naval engagements of the war with Russia including the battle of Tsu Shima straits. His squadron was long on blockade duty off Port Arthur. The Admiral, who received his naval education in England, is a world wide traveler.

TOBACCO CROP IN KENTUCKY

Louisville, Ky., Nov. 27.—The state Commissioner of Agriculture figures that the crop of the Black Patch of this year will be 20 per cent short of the 1905 crop which amounted to 653,000,000 pounds. The Commissioner in his report published today states that Japan has turned her attention to the tobacco of this country and comes in as a new consumer having bought nearly all of North Carolina's season's crop.
