Seventy-one provinces show the yield to be 15,059,surgeon 000,000 pounts or 250.935.535 bushels. and rye 638.250.000 bushels below the Residence Main 68 average. Great destitution prevails in the Balkan states and in several 3of the inerior provinces the peasanes have taken o their beds for days at a time to weaken the pangs of hunger and are mixing their scanty supply of grain with pigweed to make it more filling for bread. Odessa, always a busy grain port, is deserted as no wheat or crops of any kind were sown in the region of the Dnieper this season o wing to the disturbed state of the country There is no shipping from the ports in the sea of Ayof and thousands of persons are leaving Taganrog and Bostov for the Crimean and South as death from starvation stares them in the face in their own provinces. No steps have yet been taken by the authorities to relieve the acute distress which prevails, but it is plain that if something is not done in the very near future there will be an appalling exodus of peasants from the country.
