CROPS A FAILURE IN RUSSIA

(Scripps News Association)
St. Petersburg, Nov. 28—Announcement was made today that the wheat crop, especially in the Black Sea and South Eastern districts is the smallest for the past thirty-four years. Seventy-one provinces show the yield to be 15,059,000,000 pounds or 250,935,333 bushels, and rye 638,250,000 bushels below the average. Great destitution prevails in the Balkan states and in several of the interior provinces the peasants have taken to their beds for days at a time to weaken the pangs of hunger and are mixing their scanty supply of grain with pigweed to make it more filling for bread. Odessa, always a busy grain port, is deserted as no wheat or crops of any kind were sown in the region of the Dniester this season owing to the disturbed state of the country. There is no shipping from the ports in the sea of Ayof and thousands of persons are leaving Taganrog and Bostov for the Crimean and South as death from starvation stares them in the face in their own provinces. No steps have yet been taken by the authorities to relieve the acute distress which prevails, but it is plain that if something is not done in the very near future there will be an appalling exodus of peasants from the country.
