 Providence, R. I., Dec. 17—A large bronze statue of Jefferson Davis, president of the Confederate States, has been completed at the works of the Gorham Company here. It is about eight feet high, cast in heroic size and will be set up in Monument Avenue, Richmond, Va. It is being erected by the United Confederate Veterans Association and will be unveiled in June next.

BRITAIN AGAINST TRUSTS

 London, Dec. 17—The Soap trust is burst. The \$60,000,000 firm recently organized in Liverpool to monopolize the soap trade in Great Britain has been forced to disolve before properly entering into business because of the majority of the people condemned it. At a great mass meeting in Frafalgar Square today resolutions condemning the formation of trusts in England were passed.

MODEL READY

 New York, Dec. 17—The model for his great bronze statue "Reconciliation" has been finished by Mr. Hinton Perry. The completed statue will be erected at a cost of \$75,000 under the direction of the New York State Monuments Commission and for the battlefields of Gettysburg and Chattanooga. Mr. Perry has been engaged for a year on the statue, which is to commemorate the battle of Chattanooga, and will be erected on the summit of Lookout Mountain, about 1700 feet above the plains where the principal fighting was done. The two figures in the composition typify the reconciliation and reunited country in the blue and gray shaking hands under the flag.

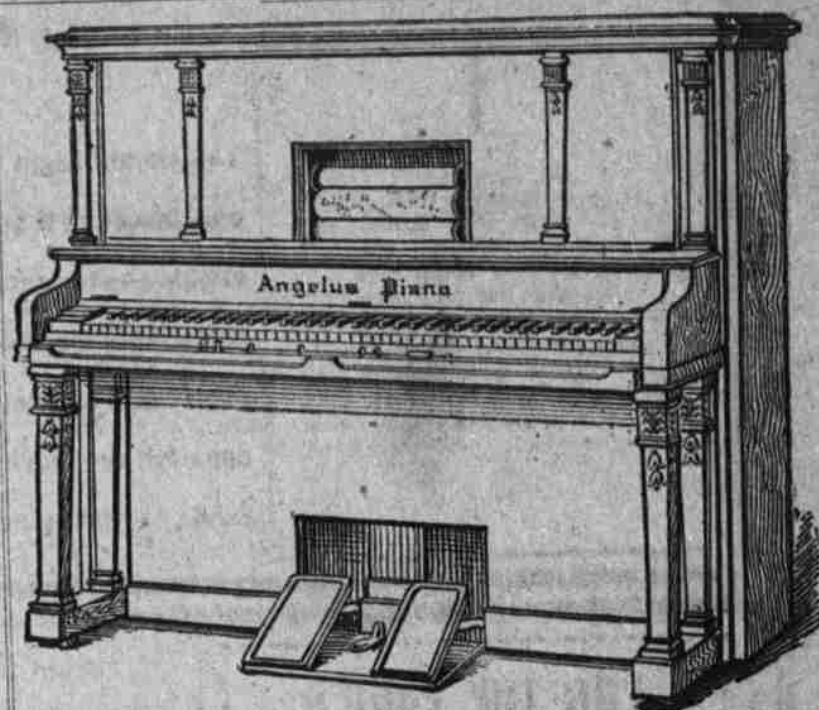
