**THE NEW OCEAN LINER**

 New Orleans, Dec 20—The Momus, the latest addition to the fleet of the Southern Pacific Steamship Co left here today for New York. She is the first of the three new steamships built for the New York-New Orleans service of the company. The Croile and Antilles were recently launched and will be placed in commission early next year.  
 The Momus, which is larger than the other two ships of 10,000 tons a seventeen knotter and an entirely new class of coast vessels. She has immense upper works which gives her the massive appearance of some of the big transatlantic liners. She has splendid cabin accommodations and is equipped with wireless telegraph apparatus. The Momus is expected to reduce the time between New Orleans and New York by thirteen hours.
