## JAPS COMMENCE BIG BATTLESHIP

(Scripps News Association)

Tokio, Dec. 20.—The keel plates of a 22,000 ton battleship were laid at the Yokosuka Navy Yard today in the presence of a great gathering of prominent naval men. The new monster will exceed the tonnage of the British battleship Dreadnought by 4000. The Japanese battleship Salsima which was launched at Yokosuka last month has a tonnage of 19,000. Besides these two craft a very large flotilla of cruisers, torpedo boats and torpedo destroyers are being built.
