UNION COUNTY GOOD ROADS ASSOCIATION IS ORGANIZED

With J. L. Caviness as President--Association will meet January Second to Prefect Organization--Committee will Wait on Solons for Better Union County Road Law.

The Good Roads Convention which closed yesterday, has done, at last one good thing for this community, and that is that it instigated the organization of a local good roads association. While the iron was still hot and before the attendants at the closing session of the convention could get away from the Commercial Club Building last evening, Turner Oliver had called Union Countyites to one corner and explained to them the necessity of an organization, composed of men from this county who desire and want to promote the interests of the valley. The suggestions met with approval and it was the work of a few minutes to begin temporary organization. A slate of officers was elected, which was headed by J. L. Caviness and Ed Reynolds, as secretary and treasurer. With considerable forethought the im-

met last night with President Scott and Secretary Thielson of Salem and learned something about the system of the state body.

That this newly organized body shall not ramble along without accomplishing something, it was decided that a committee be appointed to appear before the legislature when that body meets next January and appeal for better road laws in this valley.

Many things of great importance were enacted at that brief session last evening. Besides the things already mentioned, the meeting agreed that each vice president should canvass his respective district and learn the sentiment of the people in regards to road improvements, and report to the county court at its next session. Also that these men should solicit memberships.

This organization, if carried on with the spirit and enthusiasm which was exhibited last evening, will accomplish something in the near future and in reality be something besides a mere organization with a name. The full slate of officers follows: President, J. L. Caviness; Secretary, Karl Stackland; Treasurer, Ed Reynolds; Vice presidents, Walter M. Pierce, La Grande; W. T. Wright, Union; J. Gilkison, North Powder; J. L. McKinnis, Summerville-Imbler vicinity; J. T. Gallaway, Elgin.
