THE GOLD OUTPUT IN AUSTRALIA

(Scripps News Association)
 Melbourne, Dec. 24.—Government figures published today on the gold output in the colony show that for the eight months ended August 31st, 2,506,532 five ounces of the value of \$47,704,804 were produced as compared with 2,388,108 valued at \$49,500,108 for the same period of last year. Increases are shown in Victoria and New South Wales and decreases in Queensland and Western Australia. The shipments of gold to the United States this year amounted to \$12,453,908 and are the largest for many years.
