CRAWFORD FILES SUIT IN BAKER

Judge Tom H. Crawford of La Grande, recently appointed to the circuit bench, has begun an action in the Baker court asking \$20,000 alleged to be due him for services, and on an assignment of an account against the Highland Gold mines company.

The complaint of the judge recites that he served as counsel for the company for three years and that the retainer and the services as advisor were worth reasonably \$5000 per year. He declares that he acted as attorney in what is known as the Miller case which was won, and for which he asks \$1500. For his part as attorney in the matter of Knapp vs the Highland Gold Mines company which was favorable in its result to his clients, Mr. Crawford asks a fee of \$7000, for services really worth that he says.

In addition the complaint pleads an account of one Ed B. Diehl who furnished the company \$10,000 which account has since been assigned to the judge in return for consideration.—Baker City Herald.
