PATHETIC ACCIDENT IN BAKER CITY

Baker City, Dec 27—The joys of Christmas tide were brot to a sad end for two families of Baker City Tuesday afternoon by the sudden death of little Myron Eardley, the son of James W. Eardley, of South Baker, in the employ of the Oregon Lumber Company, by the accidental discharge of a 44-40 rifle in the hands of his playmate companion Harry Bell, about a quarter of a mile from the Bowen ranch near the line of the Sumpter Valley railway, while the boys were out hunting.

The two lads had gone out to try their luck on a Christmas holiday, and had their guns crossed over their shoulders. Young Bell in removing his gun to his arms caught the safety lever in the lapel of his coat and in some manner the rifle was fired, the bullet piercing his friend in the left breast and coming out thru the right liver. Young Eardley died instantly.

A jury agreed that Myron Eardley met his death by an accident.
