#### ORDINANCE NO. 347

(Series 1906)

An ordinance to provide a levy on the taxable property within the City of La Grande, Oregon, of a tax for general and municipal purposes and for paying interest on the bonded indebtedness of said city for the year 1907, and a poll tax.

The city of La Grande does ordain as follows:

Section 1-That a levy of seven mills on the dollar be, and the same is hereby made upon all the property within the said city assessed during the year 1906, for State and County purposes to be used and expended for paying municipal and current expenses for the year 1907.

Section 2-That a special tax of five mills on the dollar be, and the same is hereby levied upon all the property within said city assessed for State and County purposes for the year 1906, to be used in paying interest on the bonded indebtedness of said city during the year 1907.

and estimated at \$4500. Section 5-That a poll tax of \$2 is hereby levied upon each male inhabitant of said city over the age of twenty-one years and under the age of fifty years said poll tax to be used and set apart for the purpose of improving and working the streets and highways within the corporate

limits of said city. Section 4-That the Recorder be. and he is hereby instructed and directed to make a report of said levies to the County Clerk of Union county, Oregon, on or before the 1st day of January, 1907.

Section 5-This ordinance shall be published in one issue of the La Grande Evening Observer, a newspaper published within the city of La Grande. Oregon, and be and remain in full force and effect from and after the 31st day of December. 1906.

Passed by the Council of the city of La Grande, Oregon, on the 26th day of December, 1906, by 5 councilmen voting therefor and no councilmen voting against the same.
