STANDARD HEARING IS IN SESSION

(Scripps News Association)
St. Louis, Mo., Jan. 7.—The charge against John D. Rockefeller and his six associates who control the Standard Oil Company, for operating the company in restraint of trade, was opened in the United States Circuit Court here today. Rockefeller's co-defendants are Henry M. Rogers, Henry M. Flagler, Charles M. Pratt, Oliver H. Payne, William Rockefeller and John D. Archbold. In addition to these the Federal Government is charging W. A. Harris, treasurer of the National Transit Company, the Crescent Pipe Line Company and other alleged standard corporations with the same offence. The Chesapeake Manufacturing Company and the Swan and Finch Company will also be charged. Over two hundred witnesses will be examined for the prosecution. The hearing of the various charges will occupy at least four weeks.

THE N. P. INCREASES ITS STOCK

(Scripps News Association)
St. Paul, Minn., Jan. 7.—A special meeting of the stockholders of the Northern Pacific Railway Company was held here today for the purpose of considering the proposal of the directors to issue \$95,000,000 additional stock. The present capital stock of the company is \$166,000,000 and the stockholders authorized the issue of the sum named by the directors which brings the capital of the company up to \$255,000,000. Of the new issue the stockholders will have the right to subscribe to \$93,000,000 at par in proportion to their respective holdings of the present stock. The reasons assigned by the directors for making the additional stock issue as explained to the stockholders today is the rapid growth of population along the company's lines and along development of business which is daily increasing. It was stated that the increasing business was overtaxing the capacity of the line and further extension of the company's mileage was necessary.
