PLAN 46 STORY BUILDING

(Scripps News Association)
New York, Jan. 16—Work was commenced today on the great tower which is to complete the Mammoth marble office building of the Metropolitan Life Insurance Co., covering the block on Madison and Fourth Avenues from 23rd to 24th sts. It will be the loftiest building in the world rising to a total height of 657 feet and will be 46 stories high—five more than the Singer Building Tower under its amended plans. When completed it will cost \$5,000,000.
