TRIAL IS SET FOR MONDAY

(Observer Special)
Baker City Jan. 17—Circuit Judge William Smith has discharged the jury until Monday when the murder trial of the State vs Alex. Widdowson, and Ira B. Brown, charged with the murder of Willard Moody of Pine valley. So far seventy five witnesses have been subpoenaed, thirty-seven by the state. This will be one of the most expensive trials in the history of Baker county as the scene of the murder being in Pine valley the mileage of many witnesses will add to the ordinary costs of such a trial. Moody, the murdered man, was the son of one of the old pioneers of that section of the county and there is a great deal of feeling worked up. What the defense will be able to prove remains to be seen. District Attorney Lomax has given special attention to the gathering of the evidence. From the fact that Moody's body was found after being dead for several hours, there were no eye witnesses and the presumption is that the State's evidence will be largely a net work of circumstances.
