Washington, Jan 19—Consular reports show that the boycott of American goods which was recently revived at Canton is spreading all over China especially the east and north. The boycott was originally started when the United States government refused to modify the Exclusion Act. The efforts which were made in Shanghai, Pekin and other leading cities to induce the Chinese newspapers to reject advertisements of American manufactures has been successful and none are now appearing. It is stated that Germany and England are at present profiting to a considerable extent by the boycott of American goods.
