ALLOTMENTS MADE

After driving from Walla Walla to Pendleton, arriving at their destination about three o'clock in the morning, J. D. McKennon and L. A. Russell have returned home from the stockgrowers' meeting held in Walla Walla last week to make the Wenaha forest range allotment.

According to these gentlemen the range division in the Wenaha reserve was settled amicably and all interests were amply protected. The number of sheep admitted to the reserve was reduced about 20 per cent, but the number of cattle and horses admitted is practically the same as last year.

One band of Washington sheep was rejected from the Oregon division of the reserve, but most of the stockmen who grazed in the reserve last year secured the same range again for 1907.

Mr. McKennon ranges in district No. 1, including Five Points and Hilgard, and will use the same range this year that was allotted to him last year. The same is true of other Union county stockgrowers, with the exception of T. T. Glen who must range in district number two.
