# THE U. S. SUGAR BEET INDUSTRY

(Scripps News Association)  
New York, Feb. 6.—Through a comparatively new industry in the United States, the manufacture of sugar from beets has progressed at a very rapid rate during the past few years. In 1900, there were 30 establishments engaged in the manufacture of beet sugar, while in 1905 there were 51, an increase of 70 per cent. Their capital in 1905 was \$55,924,459, as compared with \$20,141,719 in 1900. The average number of wage-earners was 5,953 as compared with 1970 in 1900. The expense of running these establishments shows an increase of 552 per cent, while the cost of material used increased from \$4,805,796 in 1900 to \$14,486,876 in 1905. The value of products shows an increase of 255 per cent or from \$7,325,857 in 1900 to \$24,295,000 in 1905. Over \$11,000,000 was distributed among the farmers in the beet raising districts in payments for beets while over \$2,000,000 was paid for lime-stone, sulphur, coke and fuel. The 51 companies shown by the returns of 1905 were all owned by corporations. Michigan leads the states with the number of establishments, 19 being in that state, with a daily capacity of 12,650 tons, while the second largest beet sugar state is Colorado, with 9 establishments.
