SENATOR MORGAN IS EXPELLED

(Scraps News Association)
Denver, Feb. 7.—Senator Richard W. Morgan was today expelled from the Colorado legislature, for confessed bribery, for which he received \$750 for his vote in favoring the Cripple Creek railroad reorganization two years ago. He has been reelected for several terms but public sentiment forced the Republicans to repudiate him. Morgan declares that others are more guilty than he is and that his share was only a part of a quarter of a million dollars.

STARVING SHEEP ON GRANDE RONDE

Lewiston, Ida., Feb. 7.—Practically stranded in the Wallowa valley, a spot 50 miles distant from this city which is almost out of reach of a wagon road, the 3000 head of sheep belonging to George T. Macomber of this city are slowly starving for want of food.

The sheep are being cared for on shares by Miller Brothers, well known sheep men of this city, who allowed them to be taken to the valley when their hay gave out. They cannot be conveniently reached by wagons because of the rugged condition of the country, and it is feared that unless hay is gotten to them before long, the severe storms of the past week will overcome the greater part of the flock.

The band is valued at about \$10,000.

THE CUBAN ARMY

Havana, Feb. 5.—The Governor Major has issued a decree passing on the organization of the Cuban army. After quoting the law of 1906, providing for an increase of the rural guard to ten thousand men and the artillery to two thousand, the decree declares that all able bodied male citizens between the ages of 21 and 45 shall constitute the national forces, which shall consist of the permanent army and the force of militia. Those past the age of 45 years are liable only in cases of emergency.

WHOLE TRIBE IS SLAIN

Tangier, Feb. 6.—Troops of the Sultan attacked the only tribe of natives living near Urhsar and butchered every member of the tribe, men, women and children were slain indiscriminately, their houses were burned and their cattle and property was confiscated by the soldiers.
