WOMAN SUFFRAGISTS TO MEET

(Scripps News Association)
Chicago, Ill., Feb. 9—Reports are at hand which indicate an unusually large attendance at the thirty-ninth annual convention of the National American Woman Suffrage Association, which will hold its sessions in this city during the five days beginning next Thursday. Many noted speakers will be heard on the subject of woman's rights.

At the initial session Mrs. Charles Henriotin will preside, and the topic will be "Municipal Suffrage for Women." At the first evening meeting Mayor Dunne will welcome the visitors and President Anna Howard Shaw will deliver the annual address. At the Friday afternoon symposium the subject will be "Industrial Conditions for Women and Children." The sessions will be held in Music Hall, Fine Arts building, and during the week the delegates will pay visits to Hull House, the University of Chicago and various other institutions in and about the city.

TO INSPECT SOUTHERN NAVY YARDS
