



Washington, Feb. 20- ecretary Root and Aoki, the Japanese ambassador to this country, are busy negotiating the treaty provided against the immigration of Japanese coolles to this country, and there is every reason to believe that they will be SUCCESS.U.

It is definitely known that the Japan ese ambassador is pleased with the results of the President Schmitz San Francisco school board conference. He would have been displeased had San Francisco refused to allow properly qualified Japanese children into the public schools.
