CALL FOR BIDS

Said bridge to be of a good quality of steel and to be built upon concrete piers. Said piers are to be built about 21 feet in height; about 29 feet in width at the bottom; about 22 feet in width at the top and shall be built with a batter on the front and each side, of one foot in six. Said bids to be presented as follows: A separate bid for the construction of the bridge; a separate bid for the construction of the piers or a separate bid for the construction of the bridge and piers. Each bid shall be presented for the building of the piers for so much per cubic yard.
