

Sec. 4. A person obtaining a license under the provisions of this ordinance must not permit or allow any breaches of the peace, or disturbance of public order, by noisy, riotous or lisorderly conduct upon the premises, where he is authorized by his lisense as herein provided to so sell such intoxicaltng liquors when it is in his power to prevent the same, nor shall he sell, give or deliver any intoxicating liquors during the term of his license upon said premises to any one under the age of twenty-one years or to any habitual drunkard, nor shall he permit or employ any woman to act as waitress or bartender or allow any woman or women to frequent or lolter about said premises; nor shall any person securing such license sell, give or otherwise dispose of or deliver any intoxicating liquors to any person or persons during the voting hours of any general or special election held under the laws of the state of Oregon, or of the United States or of any city election held under the city charter of La Grande. Oregon, and any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, when convicted thereof before the city recorder of said city be punished by a fine of not less than 150 dollars, nor more than 300 dollars, or by imprisonment in the
