natural state in California, was doas Muir Woods, in honor of John Muir, the distinguished naturalist. The giant trees will now be given permanent protection, under virtue of the law which provides that objects of scientific interest may be declared national monuments. The government grove will be a pleasure ground for the people of San Francisco, Oakland and other cities in the vicinity. as well as an object of scientific interest to visitors from all parts of the world.

The chief reason for the permanent protection of the land by the government is that there is no other redwood grove in the world more accessible to so many people. The canyon is in absolutely primeval condition, not so much as scratched by the hands of man. It lies within an hour's ride of San Francisco, at the very doors of hundreds of thousands of people.

So long as the land remains in private ownership, there is always danger that the trees will be attacked. and Mr. Kent feared this, but as a national monument they will be safe,
