University of Oregon, Feb. 12 .-Special.)-Hon. R. A. Booth of Eugene, has just given to the student oan fund of the University of Orefor students. The fund will be known as the "Booth loan fund," and will to-wit: be kept separate from the general in the matter of the Guardianship of loan fund which at present is distributed in loans ranging in amount from \$15 to \$80 among 10 students of the university. Since the establishmen of the general fund five years ago, more than 30 students have been enabled to complete their college course who could not otherwise have done

The university hopes to establish to complete their education, but who annot do so without assistance. It is believed that a loan of approximately \$100 a year, at a low rate of interest, to be repaid in two years after graduation, is much more preferable than an outright gift in the form of a scholarship. The fund will be guaranteed by 10 men against loss Two signatures will be required on each note and a small amount of life insurance will be taken out to insure gainst loss by death.

The present loan fund amounts to approximately \$1000.

Grand Rapids, Mich., Feb. 12.-Secretary Taft will be given a glorious reception by the republicans of Michigan when he addresses the Grand Rapids Lincoln club at its banquer tonight. A meeting of the republican state central committee will be held this afternoon. It is said that no effort will be made to get the central committee to adopt a resolution favoring Taft for president, although the secretary is a decided favorite among Michigan republicans.

At this meeting the time and place for holding the state convention will be decided on, and temporary officers named. The state convention will probably be held late in April or early in May. Grand Rapids may lose the convention because it has now no convention hall. It is Grand Rapids' turn, but Detroit will probably get it again unless Grand Rapids citidens find a suitable place.

From here Secretary Taft will go to Detroit tomorrow and an elaborate program has been arranged for his entertainment. It includes an escort from Grand Rapids, an automobile ride to the Hotel Ponchatrain, a reception either at the hotel or the Masonic temple or Harmonie hall, and a luncheon to be held at 2:30 in the
