BIG WAGES

F. J. Heney has received a total of \$50,000 from the government since he first accepted employment as land fraud prosecutor in Oregon in 1903, says a Washington dispatch. All this as been paid excepting \$8,000 which item pends in the urgency deficiency bill, now in conference between senate and house, and as no protest has been filed, it is expected it will go through.

Heney began his labors November 7, 1903, when appointed special assistant attorney general to assist John H. Hall, district attorney for Oregon. He was to prosecute the case against Mc-Kinley, Puter, Ware, et al. His compensation was to be determined by the attorney general on completion of his

February 23, 1904, he was appointed special assistant attorney general to prosecute the Hyde-Dimond-Benson and fraud case, involving Oregon and 'alifornia irregularities, his compensation again being left to the attorney general.

October 18, 1904, he was again appointed special assistant attorney general to assist District Attorney Hall. On December 16, 1904, he resigned that position to accept an oppointment is assistant district attorney for Oregon at \$1500 per year.

During 1904 he was paid \$5000 on account of services under the special
