SPECIAL SERVICES BEING HELD IN PENDLETON

The Pendleton Tribune, in its issue of Tuesday, commenting upon the revival services that are being conducted there under Evangelist Haudenschield, who will be in La Grande in April, says:

The five churches of Pendleton engaged in the union meetings are just beginning to realize the results of this kind of work, the meetings now going on in this city have been held less than three weeks and yet the results have been greater many times over than anything else that has ever been known in the history of the city, largely a result of this union spirit which now seems to pervade these churches, and all will undoubtedly be blessed more than in any single meeting they have ever held.

Sunday was a great day in this work. At the morning service the

large new M. E. church was filled to the class rooms, including the large number of extra benches and chairs the committee had secured from every source possible a week ago. The sermon was a masterly effort upon a very practical subject and handled in such manner that all felt the sincerity of the speaker, who does not spare himself in his chosen work.

Number of conversions to date, 244.
Number of backsliders reclaimed, 102.

Amount of money raised in 12 minutes for expense of meetings Sunday morning, \$249.

Cottage prayer meetings held, 260.

Number in all the congregations out to hear the evangelist in both afternoon and evening meetings from the first, 14,500.

Catholics Buy Property.

The Roman Catholic church of Oregon has purchased 12 lots in Portland upon which stands the North Pacific sanatorium, at 19th and Gilson streets, one of the finest pieces of property in the city.

The purchase price was \$60,000, but because Dr. R. C. Coffey, who held a lease and an option on the property with still five years to run, will be paid \$12,600. Just what is the intention of the church to do with the property is not known, but it is believed that it will become the site of a costly new cathedral.

The property was formerly owned by Levi White, who up to the time of his death was one of Portland's business men. He bought it for a home in 1885, but for the past 12 years it has been used as a sanatorium and has been conducted by Dr. Coffey. The block is one of the show places of the city and is virtually a park set out in handsome trees, shrubs and towers. Five years ago Dr. Coffey obtained from the White heirs an option on the property that ran for five years with a purchase price clause of \$60,000. Dr. Coffey was not anxious to dispose of his option because his sanatorium was well known and at first he was inclined to reject the offer of the church. Portland Journal.
