COUNTY ROADS GIVEN DUSTER

As a direct result of effort made by the Neighborhood club of this city to promote a general cleaning up of both streets in La Grande and county highways in Union county, each supervisor in the county has been individually notified and instructed to make a special effort this spring to keep the roads clean of garbage and rubbish. The committee appointed by the Neighborhood club recently waited upon the county board of supervisors at the last session and thus made the first step in a crusade which will leave La Grande as a city with alleys and back yards utterly void of rubbish. The court took favorable action on the petition and instructed the county clerk to notify the supervisors, as stated.

The committee is not finished yet, and in a few days will present themselves to the council with the same requests that were made to the county board.

There are other movements on foot which will be presented as plans mature and become perfected. At this stage of the crusade, the committee is pleased with progress.

DARK FOR BASEBALL LEAGUE.

The Semi-Professional Movement Has Had a Relapse.

It is very doubtful if the semi-professional baseball move for the coming season, which included Baker City, La Grande, Pendleton and Walla Walla will ever get very far. Many lovers of the game argue that it costs too much for the class of ball that will be furnished, and others who enjoy attending a game where local people participate say they would not contribute a cent to the support of a bunch of young men who can find nothing better to do than spend their entire time with a "brush" league.

Yesterday Pendleton's old ball team withdrew from further negotiations on the subject and gave out the statement that if Pendleton entered the Wagner-O'Brien league it would have to do so without the aid or support of the old ball players who have each season kept the name of that town before the inland empire people.

There is no question but what the plans outlined by Mr. Wagner when here a few days ago will not be adopted by Baker City, although it is Walla Walla reported this city signed contracts of the league. It is probable that Baker will have a team, but the team, as things look now, will be composed of the best talent in the city, reinforced by some outside men who will work through the season at some legitimate business and play ball for a remuneration which the citizens will see fit to give.—Baker City Herald.

Pike's Original Maps Are Found.

A Colorado Springs dispatch says: General Zebulon M. Pike's original manuscripts and maps relative to explorations in 1806, which were taken from him at Chihuahua, Mexico, after his capture by the Spaniards, have been found by Herbert E. Bolton, a professor of the University of Texas, who has been making researches in the Mexican archives. News of this discovery has just been conveyed to General William J. Palmer, of this city, by Dr. Edgar Hewitt, director of the American Institute of Archaeology.

The whereabouts of the papers has been unknown ever since their capture by the Spaniards, and their discovery is one of importance, in as much as they are expected to throw light on early American history. It is expected not only to show General Pike's early explorations, but to settle the much-discussed question as to whether General Pike was implicated in the Burr conspiracy.
