Guess Size of Ballots,

A report from Salem says: With the filing of the last of the rguments upon initiative and refer endum measures yesterday, it has become possible to compute approximately the size of the pamphlets for information of voters. S. A. Kozer chief clerk of the secretary of state's to be included in the book, and concluded that the copies of bills, amend ments and arguments will occupy 126 pages at least. The cost will be about \$50 per page, or \$6000. As persons who file arguments must-pay their proportion of the total, about \$2850 has been paid by private indi-

The pamphiets will be published and ready for distribution about Apr , or two months before the people wil Secretary of State Benson is now securing lists of voters who have registered in each of the counties o the state and has clerks at work ad dressing envelopes to these voter-When the pamphlets have been prined they will be slipped into the en velopes and mailed.

State Printer Duniway will try to save the state \$1000 in postage b shaving the pamphlets a little close in the edges when he trims them. 1 is expected that the postage on each pamphlet will be 5 cents, or \$5000 or the whole 10,000 copies. Mr. Duni vay thinks that by trimming the pamplets to a slightly amailer size than the law specifies he can make them ligh enough to go for 4 cents each.
