LOWER RATES TOMORROW

There is need of revival of the Grande Ronde Boost club. Commencing with tomorrow and continuing until April 30, colonist rates will be effective from all points in the east. The result of colonist rates were plainly evident last year; hundreds will migrate to Oregon and will be looking for suitable locations. Carefully compiled boost literature would stand the county well in hand now.

The rates are not as low as they were last year. From all Missouri river common points the rate is \$30 to Portland over the O. R. & N., via Huntington or via Spokane over the other northern roads. There are two exceptions, however, as Omaha and Kansas City sales will not allow routing over any other line but the Union Pacific, over the O. S. L. to Huntington, and past or through La Grande. The fact that Omaha and Kansas City are starting points for a vast number of the colonists who will come west, due to the fact that these towns are fed by the element of the middle west which is feverish over migration to the coast, La Grande will see more tourists than any other city of Oregon, not on the O. R. & N.

This vast territory will send its homeseekers through La Grande. Real estate men believe the inflow of homeseekers will be about as lively and bring as many people as the recent rates did. Several real estate firms of this city predict a material benefit to Union county from these rates. They have been in correspondence with eastern parties and have people in line who are willing to locate in eastern Oregon. Once here, the ultimate results are unquestionable, they will stay. If the Boost club is not going to be revived, every citizen should make himself a committee of one to write to eastern friends setting forth inducements and resources of Union county.

TRI-STATE MEET SURE

Definite assurance has been given by La Grande high school that the tri-state high school track and field meet at Walla Walla will be arranged this year along lines similar to those which controlled the successful meet of last spring.

Local track and field team officials received letters and blank contracts from President Penrose of Whitman college today, setting forth the conditions under which the meet will be held. The news that the meet will occur has met with much delight here for the success of last year's meet has not been forgotten. Whitman college is to have direct

management of the meet this spring. The event is to take place on April 10, when the preliminaries will be on and on May 1, when the finals will take place. The size of the team is restricted to six members this year. This will stimulate lively competition at the La Grande high school for places on the team.

The teams which will participate are: Boise, Lewiston, Baker City, La Grande, Pendleton, The Dalles, Colfax, Ellensburg, Garfield, North Yakima, Oakesdale, Palouse, Pomeroy, Litzville, Roslyn, Spokane, Waitsburg and Walla Walla.

La Grande will be there. The contracts are to be signed today and forwarded by the first mail.

Open New Naval Prison.

Boston, Feb. 29.—In order to relieve the congestion of the naval prison here, the new naval prison at the Portsmouth, N. H., navy yard will be opened tomorrow, although only half finished. About 150 prisoners will be moved into the prison from the Boston yard. There are only 160 cells at present in the completed wing of the prison and 160 more will be placed in that wing of the building as soon as congress provides the money.

Because Judge Smith of Baker City could not be here on Monday, the Bartlett trial will not be commenced until Tuesday morning. The jury has been discharged until that date. The court today has been engaged in arranging the equity docket.

A motion made by Attorney Cochran for the O. R. & N., requesting judgment for the defendant in the Russell vs. O. R. & N. case, notwithstanding the verdict, was made this morning before Judge Crawford. The court overruled the motion. The O. R. & N. has 60 days in which to file bills of exception.
