# OFFICIAL STEP IS TAKEN

Sheriff Childers today served official notice of foreclosure proceedings, instituted by L. C. Stanley to recover \$3000 and some interest money, on President William Miller of the La Grande Commercial Club Building association. As a result, it will be something like 50 days from today when the sale of the building will take place, unless other steps are taken in the 19 days following the serving of papers.

It is presumed the Commercial club building will be open to members in these 50 days, the same as before. Unless some unforeseen action is taken in the allotted 19 days, publication of the foreclosure and sale will have to be made in five successive weekly publications.

### TO START NEWSPAPER.

Late President of Mineworkers to Publish a Peace Paper.

Indianapolis, Ind., April 2.—John Mitchell, late president of the United Mineworkers of America, today announced that he will establish and operate in this city, a daily paper devoted to the interests of the laboring classes.

"One of the principal objects of the publication will be the furtherance of peace between the miners and operators," declared Mitchell.

This announcement sets at rest the rumored appointment by President Roosevelt of Mr. Mitchell, to gather data and other statistics relative to the Panama canal.
