### THE PASTIME.

#### New Amusement Enterprise About Ready for Opening.

### GUATEMALA IN TURMOIL.

#### Refugees, Principally Wealthy Men, Are Fleeing Across Border.

Mexico City, April 29.—It is reported here from Tapachula and other points near the Guatemala frontier that hundreds of political refugees have fled across the border and that a state of terror exists among the people of the Central American state. Many of the refugees are bankers, planters, wealthy citizens and those of all walks in life. The Mexican government is massing a force of several thousand troops on the frontier and the Guatemala army is also gathering near the line. The situation is tense.

It is not usually known that it has been approved by an international delegation representing over 250 of the leading universities of the world. It is not generally known that M. Marconi, the famous discoverer of the method of wireless telegraphy, announces the fact that Esperanto will be the language used in this new business.

It is not generally known that many of the colleges and the universities of the United States have adopted it in their courses of study.

There are a few persons in La Grande who seem to have a little spirit of enthusiasm in the matter of learning it, but it appears likely to be very short lived. Have you asked anyone about it?

#### OF INTEREST TO WOMEN.

Miss Sallie Word has just been elected assessor and collector of taxes for Palestine, Texas; and Mrs. P. P. Tucker and Mrs. E. P. Turner were chosen as members of the Dallas board of education. The election of these three women followed an opinion given out by the attorney general that, under the constitution of Texas, women are eligible to municipal offices.

Miss Jane Brownlee of Toledo, O., who is in great demand for lectures

on her remarkably successful method of introducing moral education into the Toledo public schools, is a strong advocate of equal suffrage. She writes, "Woman's right to suffrage is so clearly based upon justice that it is only a question of time when it will be granted her, fully and freely."

The affirmative vote on woman suffrage in the Massachusetts legislature this year was an increase of more than 100 per cent over that of last year; while the negative vote showed a considerable decline.

Some persons have hinted that the surprisingly large vote of 271 to 92 lately given by the house of commons in favor of parliamentary suffrage for women is a "pious fraud." They intimate that the 271 members who voted for the measure never meant it to pass. But it is less than a year since the house of commons, with only 15 dissenters, passed the bill making women eligible as mayors, aldermen and councillors, which had already passed the house of lords, and is now law. It seems clear that the British parliament really holds "advanced" views on the woman question.
