HOLD ONE MORE EXAM.

As predicted by The Observer a few days ago it has become necessary to conduct another examination for city mail carriers. The two who have passed on the eligibility list do not form sufficient material to work with, and the department has called for another examination. Through Miss Mary Riesland, secretary of the board of civil service examiners, the department names May 23 as the date for this examination. It will be held in La Grande under the secretary's supervision, and the same rules that prevailed before, both prior to and at the date of examinations, will again be in force.
