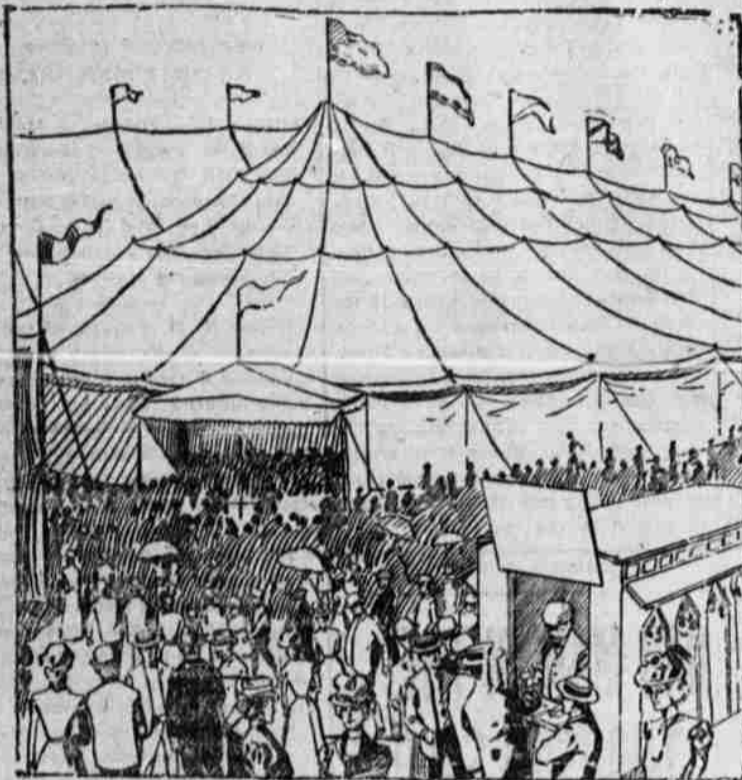

Ordinance No. 375, Series 1908.  
An ordinance changing the names of certain streets within the city of La Grande, Oregon.  
The City of La Grande Does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That the following named streets within the corporate limit of the city of La Grande, Ore. be and they are hereby changed as provided in the second section of this ordinance, and that hereafter the same shall be called and known by the names as provided in said section.

Sec. 2. That P street be changed to and known as Pennsylvania avenue.

That Tyler avenue be changed to, and known as Palmer avenue, said name to apply to the continuation of this street east along the O. R. & N. right of way to Fourth street.

That Pine street be changed to, and known as Hemlock street.

That N street in Coggin's 2nd Add. be changed to and known as East N avenue.

That O street in Coggin's 2nd Add. be changed to and known as East O avenue.

That Island avenue be changed to and known as Cove avenue.

That F street in Williamson's Add. be changed to and known as East Pennsylvania avenue.

That E street in Williamson's Add. be changed to and known as Q avenue.

That D street, in Williamson's Add. be changed to and known as R avenue.

That C street in Williamson's Add. be changed to and known as S avenue.

That B street in Williamson's Add. be changed to and known as T avenue.

That A street in Williamson's Add. and Osborn street in Predmore Add. be changed to and known as Jackson avenue.

That Parsons street be changed to and known as U avenue.

That Hill street and Pleasant street be changed to and known as V avenue.

That Harding street and Trowbridge street be changed to and known as W avenue.

That Linn street, Wagner street and Robbins street be changed to and known as X avenue.

That Douglass street, Spalding street and Roosevelt street be changed to and known as Y avenue.

That Baker street, Klamath street and Sears street be changed to and known as Z avenue.

That Curry street be changed to and known as Crook avenue.

That Cow street and Grant street in Riverside Add. and Benton street in Chaplin's Supplemental Add. "B." be changed to and known as Lane avenue.

That Jackson street in Riverside Add. and McDonald street be changed to and known as Benton avenue.

That Multnomah street be changed to and known as North Alder.

That Wallowa street be changed to and known as North Walnut street.

and in Arnold & Dray's Add., be changed to and known as Walnut street.

Sec. 3. That hereafter all streets running north and south be called and known as streets, those north of the railroad tracks with the word North prefixed thereto, and all streets running east and west be called and known as avenues.

Sec. 4. That in as much as it is desirable that the changes of the names of streets as provided in section 2 herein, be made at once in order to facilitate the delivery of mail by the carriers under the free delivery system, to be put in operation by the postoffice department an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect after its approval by the mayor and after its publication in one issue of the La Grande Evening Observer.

Passed the common council on the 8th day of May, 1908, by eight members voting therefor.

Approved on the 9th day of May, 1908. M. K. HALL, Mayor.
