# COMMISSION REPUDIATES F. W. GAINES

As announced in The Observer several days ago, there is room for doubt as to the color of the "trade" followed by one F. W. Gaines. The freight reduction scheme which he practices, has become knowledge of the Oregon railway commission, and the following self-explanatory letter is the outcome:

Salem, Ore., May 13, 1936.—(To the Editor of The Observer.)—Dear Sir: Our attention has been called to an article in a recent issue of your paper with regard to Mr. F. W. Gaines who is said to be promising farmers in Union county that he will secure a reduction of freight rates charged for the transportation of their products, in return for which service he is to receive a percentage of such reduction. We note his claim that he is working in conjunction with the railroad commission of Oregon, and address you in this regard lest some misapprehension arise as to the true state of facts.

The only correspondence we have had with Mr. Gaines has been with reference to the effect of the recent order of the commission which made a reduction in the class rates between Portland and points east of The Dalles. In a letter under date of May 4th we explained this matter to him very carefully, and have not heard from him since. If he contemplates bringing the matter of rates on grain or any other product before the commission, we have received no advice to that effect. In any case, no reduction of a rate can be ordered by the commission without a formal complaint being filed, an opportunity being given the railroad company to answer, and a public hearing being had at which the railroad company and all interested parties may appear and be heard. Moreover, no voluntary change in rates can be made by any railroad company without giving 10 days' notice to the commission, and posting notice of such change in every depot station and office where an agent is maintained for 10 days before the change takes place. In this manner full publicity is given to changes in rates and there is no opportunity to discriminate between shippers by means of "midnight" rates and other like devices.

We are glad at all times to answer questions as to the activities of the commission, as our work is open to the public and may be inspected at any time by those interested. No person is entitled to or receives any more of the confidence of the commission than the public at large. We shall be very glad to have you give this communication publicity and thanking you in advance for the courtesy, we are,
