John Mars has shot his cheap real estate up a peg or two since the temporary restraint was granted against the county court yesterday enjoining that body from declaring the local option law effective. During the days that his real estate took such a terrific slump, he disposed of a valuable piece of property to N. K. West for \$500. He had a standing proposition on his Adams avenue property that would make a man's eyes stick out, but the "bills" got control of the market and the property is now more valuable. The "bears" may win out yet, for should the injunction against the county court be dissolved, it is predicted that the Mars pit will be the scene of another slump.

Since last evening the property owner maintains his "cheap" property is disposed of.

Charged With Perjury.

On the alleged charge that Chas. Carsten, proprietor of the Baker City Dyke works, had sworn falsely in proving up a desert land claim in the state of Colorado in 1902, United States Marshal Terry arrived from Portland last night and this morning placed Carsten under arrest. A preliminary hearing was held before U. S. Land Commissioner C. A. Moore, and Carsten's bonds were fixed at \$1000, which he put up in cash.

The defendant has been a resident of Baker for about seven years, conducted his business in a quiet way, has paid his bills and stands well with the business people here. He has many friends who feel that this unpleasant matter will be cleared away satisfactorily when once the case is tried before a federal court, at which time details will be gone into that a preliminary hearing is not supposed to touch upon.—Baker City Herald.
