HAYWARD TO LONDON.

Coach "Bill" Will Study Athletics in the East This Summer.

University of Oregon, Eugene, June 15.—(Special.)—The Associated Students of the University of Oregon will send "Bill" Hayward, Oregon's famous trainer, east this summer. Hayward will take six weeks in the Yale summer school, perfecting himself in the most approved methods in training and physical culture, and studying the best forms of gymnasium apparatus and equipment, and will also inspect a large number of the most prominent university and other gymnasiums of the eastern states. Hayward will be away from Oregon for a couple of months or more, and will have charge of the training of Dan Kelly and probably Forrest Smithson for the Olympic games. He will accompany the American team to London.
