**NEAR-BEER IN LA GRANDE**

**SUBSTITUTE FOR LAGER COMES IN BOTTLES.**

La Grande Gets in Line With Other Dry Cities in the State and Will Deal in Near Beer—Shipments Soon to Come in Kegs—Cost of Production Higher Than Beer.

Near beer will be for sale in La Grande hereafter, this city having followed the footsteps of nearly all other cities in the state that went the way of the "dry" at the recent election. That popular beverage that looks like beer and tastes like lager, has become a fit substitute for the real stuff and it very likely will become popular in this city. Brewers in wet counties have been looking into the methods of manufacture, and find it can be manufactured with profit, though the selling price is higher than real beer.

The first shipment to this city comes in bottles, but it is expected that kegs will be the shipments to follow. Ulrich Lotter will be one of the first to deal in the substitute for beer.
