CONCRETE BRIDGE.

Tried by Walls Walls and Found to Be the Best.

By placing a 50-ton test on the new concrete bridge across Mill creek on Fourth street, yesterday afternoon about 4 o'clock, the formal test by city officials before accepting the new structure was made, says the Walla Walla Bulletin. It is probable that the bridge will be accepted at the meeting of the city council this evening and the contract price ordered paid to the contractor, F. E. Nelson.

The test was made by use of the two heavy fire engines, weighing together 19 tons, the large steam roller, weighing 12 tons and the smaller horse roller, weighing seven tons. Besides this a team hauling one of the fire engines was on the bridge at the time the test was made.

Dirt weighing between 20 and 30 tons has been used on the bridge, and this, together with the combined weight of the fire engines, rollers and team, made a weight of over 50 tons placed on the bridge at one time. It was expected that there would be some deflection, as the structure is 47 feet in length, but there was not the slightest give.
