NEW FIRM TO BE FORMED

SUFFICIENT CAPITAL TO MEET ALL DEMANDS.

To Handle Fruit of This Valley, With the Parr-Simmons Warehouse as Its Headquarters, is the Purpose of a Firm About to be Incorporated—Ramsay, Oldenburg and Logan the Incorporators.

With a three-year lease on the Parr-Simmons fruit warehouse in their possession, and about to take final steps to organize themselves into a corporation with the express purpose of dealing in fruits which are growing in the Grande Ronde valley, Messrs. Garrit Oldenburg, Ray W. Logan and C. O. Ramsay—all local men—are about to incorporate with ample capital to meet demands.

With the splendid warehouse facilities afforded by the Parr-Simmons structure on Jefferson avenue, and with ample capital to buy and ship fruit unhampered, the incorporation, which is yet unnamed, will be in position to do an expansive business. While the process of incorporation has not been inaugurated as yet, such is the purpose of these three men, however, and it is expected that the papers will be filed in a few days. Two of the gentlemen, Messrs. Oldenburg and Ramsay, are experienced fruit men, and with Mr. Logan's business ability, the firm should be well engineered.

Incorporation always means additional stability to any firm and every additional incorporation that is added to the city's list of enterprises, is desirable. Though Messrs. Ramsay and Oldenburg have been engaged in buying and shipping fruit for the past several years, there will no doubt be a noticeable expansion in their already extensive business as a result of the recapitalization and incorporation which is to follow.

TO TAP WALLA WALLA.

Branch to Garden City Will Leave the Main Line Near Ritzville.

Walla Walla is to have another railroad, which will cut the distance from the Garden City to Spokane 57 miles, the new line to be 143 miles long. In a recent issue of a Spokane paper full details of the proposed line are given, showing maps of territory through which the road will pass, says a paper of that city.

The Walla Walla line will branch off from the main road from Spokane to Portland at Cow creek junction, near Ritzville. Already part of this branch has been surveyed and plans are being rapidly formulated for starting actual work on the road as soon as possible. President Strahorn and his associates rely on the perfection of the roadbed, slight grades and curves, to bring returns from this road which will be greater than those derived from others because of the comparative small expense of the North Coast with lines of other companies.
