

the leaves begin to curl, cut them out. But this is not all. Cut the dying limb back far enough to get all of the discased part, then disinfect the end of the lime with a solution of corrosive sublimate, the specific name being ermuric chloride, which comes in tablet form. Take four tablets to a pint of water and apply with a sponge or swab. Also be careful to disinfect you do not you are liable to do more damage than you do good. Then do not forget to burn all of the dead limbs up. Do not let these disease breeders lay around the premises.


