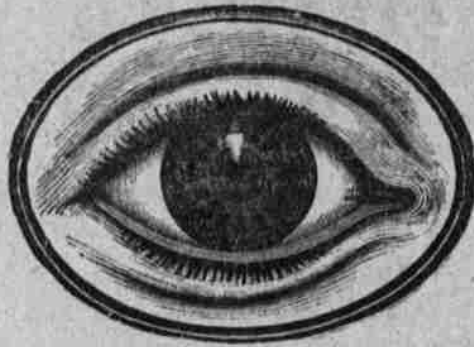

## STOP IRRIGATING DURING FIRE.

Clause in New Charter Will Provide for Better Fire Protection.

When the new charter is adopted, there will be in it a provision which will protect the water pressure during time of fire. The fire last evening brings forcible illustration of the defect in the charter and ordinances at the present time. Taking for granted that the department had not done such prompt and effectual work last evening, that bonfire would have meant the destruction of an entire block of business houses. Under present regulations, property owners could have let their irrigation hose continue to play on the lawns while the water would have been needed at the scene of fire. In other cities such provisions are made by ordinances, and it will be incorporated in the charter that is now in the last stages of perfection. It is the plan of the city attorney to insert a clause which will make the property owners amenable to a heavy fine if they do not shut off all irrigation streams as soon as the fire alarm is sounded. It is unquestionably a step in the right direction for the protection of property.

Another feature of fire protection which the council will take under advisement, and which Mayor Hall has already touched upon in a special message to the council, is the matter of burning rubbish in alleys. That fire last evening is an example of many lessons which need teaching. The council should follow the mayor's request and provide for heavy fines on anyone burning rubbish in the streets or allowing it to accumulate there.
