

County Bridge Inspector J. P. ampbell returned yesterday from a trip up the Grande Ronde river, where he made a careful inspection of all the bridges crossing that stream. He ands that two new bridges practically need to be replaced with new ones. and he will so report to the county ourt at its next session. Union ounty now has 23 bridges, counting only those with more than a 40-foot span. Six of these bridges are steel structures and four are combination structures. Mr. Campbell informs us that the court has decided to do its own construction work for a while, believing that a substantial saving to the taxpayers can be made thereby, the first bridge to be erected under the plan will be the steel one across Catherine creek at Union. It is be lieved that a saving of \$1000 can be made on this one bridge. Mr. Campbell has had many years' experience

thoroughly capable of successfully overseeing the work. The Union county court is ever on the look out for an opportunity to make every dollar expended bring full value in return and there seems to be no reason to believe that this new plan will result in better bridges at a lessened cost.
